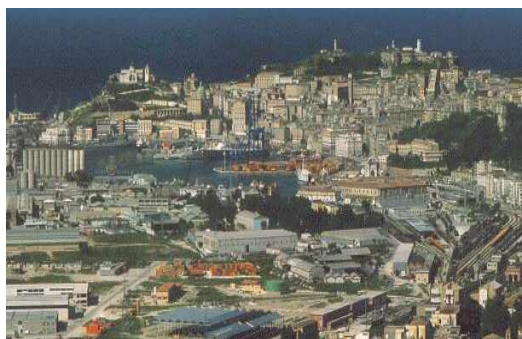

The Psychonaut Web Mapping Project is a EU Commission-funded project with the aim of developing both a web scanning system and a database to categorise novel recreational psychoactive compounds/new trends in drug use based on information available on the Internet. It aims both at implementing a regular monitoring of the web with respect to novel recreational drugs, and at setting up a system that can formally liaise with the existing EMCDDA European Early Warning System (EWS). The final objective of the Psychonaut project is to promote public health and to reduce drug related harm.
